Say the image is named img.jpg: img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg img.jpg Is there any way to do this, without using HTML tables? I have played with grid-view, but that didn't work out well. Is it possible to use only CSS and HTML, without Javascript? A: You'll have to use the display:table style (and only then as the answer by Amal Tigga also correctly says). Unfortunately, CSS can't make use of your graphic's row and column orientation. With your image in the first column and text in the second, it's still a six-column grid. And if you add a fourth column to display text, you'll have a 4-by-4 grid. With your graphic in the first row, first column and text in the second, you'll have a 3-by-3 grid. So CSS will only make use of the z-index (without negative values) and the CSS position attribute, that will place an element to a particular position (z-index doesn't affect positioning, this is only about stacking). Perhaps there are options to display a grid with CSS, but I don
