Rename this file and you'll find the executable DBViewer again. Now you can rename this file and you'll have the DBViewer.exe executable in your computer. You'll just need to run it and you'll find all the files which were on your C:\Users\YourUserName\AppData\Local\Temp folder. Hope this helps. The student journalists at Ohio State University — the ones who wrote the harrowing series of articles on a college women's health clinic that catapulted them to Internet infamy last spring — are suing the university and its fraternities for fraud. In a lawsuit filed last month, the student journalists accuse Ohio State University's Greek community of fraudulently working with the university to cover up the clinic's mishandling of sexual assault complaints against its male students, thus ruining the journalists' reputations and potentially damaging their futures at the university. [Federal data: Colleges get hundreds of thousands of rape and sexual assault complaints every year.] The allegations are part of a wider debate about whether fraternities and other campus groups have a responsibility to investigate sexual assault allegations against their members. But it is unusual for students to sue universities for making those allegations public. As evidence, the students point to an unusual complaint that Ohio State filed with the federal government about the clinic's conduct. The complaint, obtained by The Columbus Dispatch, suggests that Ohio State received over 150 complaints about the clinic's conduct in the past decade. Of those, about 40 were from university students. Sigurd Østeng Sigurd Østeng (29 July 1915 – 15 August 1945) was a Norwegian resistance member and Communist Party member of the Norwegian Parliament.
