There are two regex functions with the same issue, so you may want to use: `preg_match_all` `preg_replace_callback` On the second issue, the reason the `.only` appears to work on the last line is that your regex is incorrectly matching the whole line in this particular case. To fix this, you can adjust your regex to match a line containing a `.` character. Change:
