The easiest way to do this in Windows 10 is to hit Start and type powercfg -?. 5 – Enable Automatic Display Power Saving The powercfg -l command shows a list of your display devices and their current configuration. If you wish to see what it looks like with the current settings, you need to turn off monitor power saving features with the powercfg -a DisplayRestart parameter. However, if you are not on a Windows 7 or 8/8.1/10 operating system, the DisplayRestart attribute might be not present. Instead, you will have to use the DisplayRestart registry key. If you want to go the registry route, you can activate the registry tweak or the powercfg -w. If you're not comfortable with the registry route, there are some more advanced Windows 10 power options that you can try. For example, if you are using the latest Windows 10, you can turn on and off Automatic Display Power Saving via Display Settings. On Windows 10, this option is available in Display Settings and, to do this, just click the checkbox to show the Power Saving option and select Power Scaling from the drop-down menu. After you do this, you can always check that your screen is off and your system is sleeping by using the dscpls -?command. As you can see, if it is not selected, your display is not turned off and if you are not asleep, then you will not see your screen go dark. How to enable and disable automatic display power saving on Windows 10 In Windows 10, you can also enable and disable the automatic display power saving feature. This is a great option to have on Windows 10 as you can activate it or deactivate it via the Windows Display app. If you want to disable the automatic display power saving, you need to go to Settings > Power and select Change what displays go dark. On the left panel, you can see the current selection – Always, Sleep and Off. If you do not see the option 1a22cd4221
