BitTorrent is a peer-to-peer application. It makes it possible to share files over the internet using similar techniques used for searching for files on the web or communicating with each other over an instant messaging system. BitTorrent works by making use of many connections (called peers), which exist on the network at any given time. Each peer has a unique "IP address", which is used to identify the peer, but it never communicates with the actual IP addresses of other peers. Instead, it communicates with other peers using the information (called "messages") stored in a special data structure called a "block chain". You are not limited to just downloading torrent files, as BitTorrent offers a large selection of addons. One of these addons, just by the name itself, is BitTorrent Generator. It allows users to create their own torrent files and share it with others. But beware of the file sizes, as it may consume a lot of space on your device. How does BitTorrent work? If you are looking for the simplest way to download and share files, BitTorrent may be the perfect tool. BitTorrent downloads or uploads data from or to peers (other users of the network) without the need for the peers to communicate with each other. BitTorrent works in the background, which means that, although you are browsing the web, you are actually making use of BitTorrent's peer-to-peer technology. You can use it to download or upload anything: files, software programs, video and audio, the lot. BitTorrent is not a download manager. It does not transfer, compress, or reorder files. BitTorrent offers file sharing because it is a user-friendly, fast and secure technology that does not rely on intermediaries. BitTorrent is based on the concept of a small network of peers. Peers are computers on the network that have the same file available for download. In contrast to conventional file sharing, where a central server holds the entire file, BitTorrent creates a peer-to-peer network where each peer can hold one piece of the file and share it with other peers. BitTorrent can divide a large file into pieces and send each piece to different peers. This way, the file is split into smaller pieces while at the same time a smaller amount of data is transferred. The main benefit of this process is that the peers do not have to wait for the file to be downloaded completely before starting the download of the next piece.
