Richard Bourne Sir Richard Bourne (23 August 1796 – 20 December 1855) was an English architect, surveyor, civil engineer and architect of military engineering works. Early life and career Bourne was born in London, the son of architect Sir John Bourne and nephew of the architect Benjamin Haydon. He was educated at The King's School, Worcester, matriculated at Trinity College, Oxford in 1813, and in 1815 graduated with a first class in classical moderation, and with a second in mathematics. His legal education was completed at the Inner Temple in 1816, but he never practised as a barrister. In 1817 he returned to Oxford as a Fellow of Oriel College, but in 1820 he

decided to set up in practice. In 1820 he was awarded the Chevalier (i.e. honorary) of the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors. From 1820 to 1825 he was employed on a large portion of the Chelsea Tunnel. In 1825 he was employed to survey and prepare plans for the South Western Railway. From 1827 to 1831 he designed, with Benjamin West, the interior of the Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery. In 1831, he went to Paris, where he was appointed architect to the railway department of the Société d'Encouragement, which was responsible for the construction of the Jardin d'École and the Jardin des Plantes. He remained in France until 1834, when he returned to England, and was appointed architect to the East India Company. In 1837, he was knighted for his services to the railway department of the East India Company. Career in India Bourne spent four years in India, during which time he prepared, with Professor Procter of the Royal Indian Institute, the plans for the town of Darjeeling. He also prepared the plans for, and supervised the construction of, the military cantonments at Kamachi, Esogawa, and Gampha. He completed the Nawab of Dhaka's new mint and observatory, and was employed to prepare the plans for a new mint at Rampur, in 1838. His services were well appreciated by the British administration, and on his return to England in 1842 he was awarded a L.C.D. by the University of Oxford. In 1844 he was appointed Resident Engineer for Assam, and in this capacity designed and carried out the construction of the Assam Railway. He also had a number of other
